Dear Ron:

Enclosed are the donor demographics of the Cedars-Sinai blood donors involved in a suspected case of post transfusion AIDS in a [redacted] male [redacted]. This case was reported to us by our Director of Neonatology, Jefferey Pomerance, who was informed of the case by Children's Hospital Department of Pediatrics. The child died at Children's hospital approximately [redacted].

The patient was born at Cedars-Sinai, [redacted] and was treated in the neonatal intensive care unit where he received numerous transfusions.

One of the male donors in this case [redacted] is a common donor with two of our other cases of suspected post transfusion AIDS. The other cases, which were previously reported to you, are [redacted] (reported November 15, 1984) and [redacted] (reported December 29, 1983). In addition to [redacted] there are five other common donors with the [redacted].

Hopefully, this information will aid in the investigation of these suspect donors, and if I can be of further assistance, please don't hesitate to call me.
